The New Castle Sailing Club owns a fleet of sailboats comprised of eight 17-foot Thistles and five 19-foot Flying Scots. We sail in the Delaware River Basin from the south end of Battery Park in New Castle, Delaware. We own a clubhouse and sail barn located at 614 South St. in New Castle and we also lease a sail house at Battery Park. We strive to make sailing a fun and interesting experience for all our members by hosting a number of social and sailing activities throughout the year.

Membership Details:

Membership in the club is limited to 130 families so that demand does not exceed boat availability. After demonstrating satisfactory sailing skills, a member can take out a boat at any time. The club offers many opportunities to connect with your fellow sailors such as spring lunches when we gather for boat maintenance, and social cruises throughout the sailing season. Sailing Instruction
